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## Minutes of meeting of BOS-Home Science

Meeting of Board of Studies (BOS) of Home Science was held on 12/09/2013.

The following members were present:

The following members were not present in the BOS but they have given their approval to participate through digital circulation.

The following points were discussed, deliberated and resolved in the meeting:

1. It was decided to launch one year diploma course in dietetics and nutrition (DCDN) in the current session. The programme structure and syllabi were approved (Appendix 1). Eligibility for admission in DCDN shall be 10+2. The minimum and maximum duration of the program shall be 1 year and 3 years respectively and would be conducted on the semester pattern. It was further resolved that initially the study material of above mentioned case would be used




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- from IGNOU, Delhi or subsequently from other open Universities like UP Rajshree Tandon Open University Allahabad. The University will develop its own SLM/identify publisher to provide SLM to its learners.
2. It was decided to launch M.A Home Science. The programme structure and syllabi were approved (Appendix 2). The eligibility for the admission in the programme shall be B.A Home Science. The minimum and maximum duration of the programme shall be 2 years and 6 years respectively.
  3. The course content of existing BA Home Science was restructured, both syllabi as well as the programme structure were approved by the committee (Appendix 3). Efforts are on to develop its SLM. The restructured content programme will be put into effect from the current session.
  4. It was decided to launch a six- month certificate course in Child care and nutrition and a certificate in foods and nutrition. The certificate course will be adopted/ adapted from IGNOU, Delhi or other open Universities like UP Rajshree Tandon Open University Allahabad. The programme structure and syllabi were approved (Appendix 4). The minimum and maximum duration of the programme six month and 1 year respectively and exams shall be conducted semester wise. It was agreed to start the programme initially with the course material from the above- mentioned University, until the University develops its own SLM.
  5. The committee also approved the names of the unit writers, experts, examiners for the programmes of Home Science and Food nutrition etc.
  6. It was also resolved to revise the book format as well as fee structure of ongoing diploma programme in public health community nutrition.
  7. It was proposed to hold a workshop under collaboration mode with Kumaun University on food hygiene & sanitation.
  8. The Coordinator of the Home Science was authorized by the committee to take all the necessary academic decisions for the overall academic development of the Home Science programmes and its learners at large.
