





Minutes of BOS (Home Science) held on 11th January, 2016 at 11.30 a.m. in the
Conference Hall, UOU Campus, Haldwani.


A meeting of Board of Studies (Home Science) was held on 11th January, 2016 to discuss about various agenda items pertaining to Department of Home Science including discussion about the syllabus and course structure of Post Graduate programme (M.A.) in Home Science proposed to be started from the next academic session, i.e., 2016-17. 1. The members of BOS consented to start M.A. Home Science programme from the next academic session, i.e., 2016-17. The programme will be of total 68 credits divided in four semesters. The minimum and maximum duration of the programme will be 2 years and 6 years respectively.
2. The syllabus and course-contents of M.A. (Home Science) were discussed. Some necessary corrections and modifications were made in the syllabus already approved by members of expert committee. The corrected copy of course contents is enclosed herewith and marked as Annexure-1.
3. The details of practical topics and on the job training/internship were discussed and finalized after the suggested modifications and corrections incorporated by the Board of Studies and the same are enclosed herewith as Annexure-2.
4. The members of Board of Studies suggested including the option for Dissertation work in fourth semester along with on the job training/internship. The students will have to opt for one option. The students opting for the dissertation work will need to follow the guidelines for dissertation as provided by the university.
5. Members of the Board of Studies identified and approved the names of course writers, course editors, translators, paper setters/moderators and evaluators for the development of Self Instructional Learning Material and other academic work related to Department of Home Science. A cumulative list is developed and the same is enclosed herewith as Annexure-3.
6. The revised project guidelines of Diploma in Public Health and Community Nutrition were presented before the board for approval. The board approved the revised guidelines and the same are enclosed herewith as Annexure- 4.
7. The subject combination options with Home Science in B.A. interschool programme were revised and the board suggested some modifications in the subject combination options presently being offered. The revised subject combination options are enclosed herewith as Annexure-5.
8. The Board suggested a programme fee of Rs. 4000/- per semester for M.A. Home Science. In fourth semester the students will have to submit an additional Rs. 1500/- as dissertation/internship fee. The remuneration for the guide/counselor, external and internal evaluator, practical exams and viva voce will be as per university guidelines.
9. The Board suggested organizing 5-6 days workshop for students of M.A. Home science in each semester. The workshop will include counseling sessions for students and revision of practical activities related to the curriculum.
10. The Board proposed to recruit additional faculty member in the Department of Home Science as with the start of M.A. Home Science programme, the academic work will definitely increase.
11. It was suggested by the Members that the Department of Home Science, DSB Campus, Nainital could be the potential study centers for students of B.A. (Home Science) and M.A. (Home Science). Board also suggested gathering detailed information about potential study centers before launching P.G. programme in Home Science.

The meeting ended with thanks to the chair and also to all the Members of the Board.
