**Section-B****(Short Answer Type Questions)**

**Note :** Section ‘B’ contains eight (08) short answer type questions of eight (08) marks each. Learners are required to answer *four* (04) questions only.

1. Discuss the characteristics of a Shakespearean tragic hero.
2. What is the significance of the closet scene between Hamlet and his mother ?
3. Examine the view that Cleopatra represents the “Superhuman Vitality” of Egypt.
4. Write a note on the use of magic in *The Tempest*.
5. Analyse the importance of the play within the play, “Pyramus and Thisbe” in *A Midsummer Night’s Dream*.
6. Discuss the importance of the role of the comic characters, Stephano and Trinculo in *The Tempest*.
7. “Clandius is more than a Melodramatic Villain.” Discuss.
8. “*Antony and Cleopatra* is a tragedy of passion and fatal love.” Discuss.
