Section-'B'

(Short-Answer Type Questions)

Note: Section B contains eight (08) short-answertype questions of eight (08) marks each. Learners are required to answer any four (04) questions only. $4\times8=32$

- "Life, like a dome of many-coloured glass, / Stains the white radiance of Eternity". Explain.
- 2. "Was it a vision, or a waking dream? / Fled is the music:— do I wake or sleep?" Comment on the note of doubt in these lines.
- Write a short note on the theme of the poem "Tithonus".
- **4.** Comment in brief on the note of melancholy in Arnold's poetry.
- "Datta. Dayadhvam. Damyata. / Shantih shantih shantih". Explain.
- 6. Describe briefly the central idea of the poem "In Praise of Limestone".
- Comment briefly on the theme of the poem "Ambulances".
- Write a short summary of the Ted Hughes' poem "Daffodils".
