a) Programme mission and objectives-



e) Instructional Design-


The program LL.M-17 offered by Uttarakhand Open University is a two year program with 10 papers of 6 credits each and a Dissertation of 12 credits, total 72 credits, having six papers in the first year namely:

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The University has in-house printed material available both in English and Hindi which is timely dispatched to the Study Centers for the distribution to the students, beside the printed material Video Lectures facility is also available. Students have facility to clarify their doubts through E mails. Qualified Faculty is appointed to rectify the queries and doubts. Doubt clearing sessions are also organized for better understanding of syllabus.

f) Procedure for Admission, Curriculum transaction and evaluation-

Admission is available to all the law graduates Practicing Advocates and other Legal Experts having LL.B degree with 50% marks, 5% relaxation is given to the students of reserve category belonging to the State of Uttarakhand. Online admission and direct admission both facilities are available, Fee of the course is Rs 16050 for the first year and Rs 16900 for the second year. Exam are conducted in the month of December for the students enrolled in the winter session and in the month of June for the students enrolled in the summer session. Information regarding assignment, exams dates, Dissertation, Viva Voce are properly convey to the students through University Website, Distribution of printed material is ensured by the University through study centers. Evaluation of answer sheet is done by experts of the relevant area or field.

g) Requirement of the laboratory, support and library Resources-

Laboratory is not required for the programme LL.M but Library facility with plenty of Books available in the University.

h) Cost estimate of the programme and the provisions-

Cost estimation of the course is INR 15 Lakh.
